---

## HITECH REQUIREMENT READY

---

There is only one Nationwide service available *right now* to meet the 2011 HITECH requirements of “interoperability” and “meaningful use”: MedUnity’s SMREx (“Sim-R-Ex”) service.

Starting in 2011 practices will be required to electronically exchange medical information and provide patient access to medical records in order to satisfy the proposed principles of “interoperability” and “meaningful use” as defined in HITECH. Unfortunately, most practices currently rely on the fax machine as the primary tool to exchange medical information with other practices. As a result, EMR and other software vendors will have to support the electronic exchange of information in addition to faxing as part of their software.

MedUnity understands the pressure that practices and EMR vendors are under to make sure they meet the HITECH requirements for 2011. As part of HITECH, vendors are being asked to design and implement an electronic exchange of information that will be compatible with their competitor’s products.

## What is MedUnity’s SMREx® Service?

---

SMREx is also the only HIE that combines both pure electronic and fax based exchange and CPOE into one service. SMREx an internet based, simple to use, low cost, is the only complete Nationwide Health Information Exchange (HIE) service publically available to the US healthcare industry. When recipients are not a member of the SMREx service, the “fax by default” system assures delivery.

**For about the same monthly cost as a single fax line**, SMREx based practices can send and receive electronic medical documents such as PDF, HL7, XML, CCD, DOC and more. SMREx can even **convert HL7/XML** to printable formats for electronic or fax delivery. SMREx works with data in whatever format is needed. All SMREx recipients are identified by their existing fax number, so there is no “new” numbering system for users to learn.

**SMREx supports EMR and Non-EMR practices as equals.** SMREx is easy to learn and can be installed and running in less than an hour. SMREx includes everything necessary to meet the proposed HITECH HIE requirements.

## SMREx Patient Records Online (PRO)

---

“Meaningful Use” requires practices to **allow patients electronic access** to information regarding recent visits. **SMREx handles this requirement with ease.** Patients will leave the practice with a one-time SMREx key code that allows them access to their information via the SMREx.com web site. Practices will simply use SMREx to post the visit information once it is completed and patient will have access to that record.

## State HIE / HIN / RHIO Interoperability

---

SMREx is all about securely getting data to anyone with HIPPA approval in any format possible. State HIE/HIN and RHIO’s are no exception. That is why MedUnity has committed itself to developing interfaces with **all the State HIE’s**. SMREx can also interface with RHIO’s too using a variety of HL7, XML, PDF, and other formats.

## CPOE and Patient Intake

CPOE and Patient Intake are key requirements for any well run practice. That is why SMREx also has the ability to **create and retrieve SMREx hosted web forms and templates**, auto-fill them with demographics, and **send the information** using SMREx. SMREx also includes generic patient **intake forms** that patients can fill in online and send via SMREx saving time and effort for every patient visit.
